Nevertheless, we sometimes balk at the thought that we are totally dependent upon God. ### ST MICHAEL THE ARCHANGEL HIGH SCHOOL

In early September, another milestone was achieved as preparation continues for site work at the Lee’s Summit site for St. Michael the Archangel High School. The project received a pledge that secures the Loan Reserve Fund requirement for the tax exempt bonds through the entire term of the loan, if needed. This reserve pledge allows all additional gifts to be used to drive down debt, enhance phase one development, and build a scholarship fund. Work continues on final bond paperwork, easement acquisition and planning for earthwork later this fall. The site is restricted as the contractor secures it and prepares to move in heavy equipment sometime late October to early November after final hay cutting is complete and old buildings are razed. # ADULT FAITH FORMATION

## REFLECTION ON THE TWENTY-SEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME , YEAR B

Many themes surface in today's readings – marriage and divorce, the attitude towards children, the willing sacrifice of self for another, the dignity and equality of all human beings, along with other themes. Responsorial Psalm 128 offers a way of dealing with these themes by giving us a lens that helps focus our thoughts.

**Psalm 128 offers a picture of several moments in the life of a wise person.** The psalm presents rich images concretizing the fruits of those who search for wisdom. The fruits are specified in terms of a happy, contented and fruitful home, with abundant food, and with relationships in their proper order. A fruitful, happy home symbolizes the blessings of God upon the people and the land, ultimately resulting in *shalom*, the sense of wholeness that is the reward of one who continually searches for wisdom by fearing the Lord and walking in God's ways.

**The sacrament of marriage is often portrayed as the primary sacrament of human community.** It is a sign of what all of life is meant to be, a life lived in relationship with others and focused on fearing the Lord and walking in God's ways. This does not mean that all are intended to be married. Rather it focuses on marriage as the model of what human relating is about. It highlights the insight and wisdom that God's expresses in the first reading: "It is not good for the human being to be alone."

**The first reading tells of God creating animals for that very purpose, i.e. to be in relationship with the human.** But none proves to be a suitable partner. God finally creates another human being. When the first human being sees the second human being, recognition of difference as well as equality is acknowledged, along with a strong affinity for union. The longing for unity, while acknowledging differences, is the foundation of any relationship, especially marriage.

**In the second reading from Hebrews, the author shows how Jesus modeled for us the essential component of any relationship – the willingness to give of oneself totally for the other.** Jesus' attitude

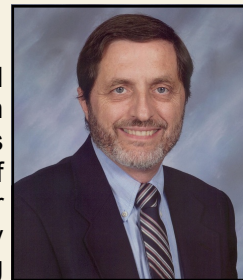
enables us to come into filial relationship with God in and through Jesus' association with us as brother. The willingness to give of self for the sake of the other strengthens the bonds of any relationship. This modeling becomes the source of strength and peace for those finding relationships difficult. Jesus enables us to be linked in familial relationship with all those who are attempting to live a life in fear of the Lord, walking in God's ways. Such is the true source and strength of any community.

**In the gospel reading, Mark has Jesus focus on the demands of relationship, most especially marriage.** To fear the Lord and to walk in God's ways is to cultivate unity amidst differences. God intends such unity for all humanity in the Genesis reading while the Hebrews reading has Jesus model how such unity is to be achieved. Working towards such unity presents many obstacles. Our call is to cultivate an attitude of working through obstacles, even to the point of being willing to sacrifice self for the other.

**We commit ourselves to work toward creating community to ensure that human relationship is fostered and human dignity is respected.** This is difficult work. Relationships can fall apart. Mark has Jesus continue to model what such work entails by taking a little child whose dignity and equality was questioned by the culture and making the childlike attitude of trust and dependence the hallmark of what fearing the Lord and walking in God's ways entails. If we do this, then no matter what happens, peace will be upon us and upon the entire human family.

**Let us recommit ourselves to fostering human relationships** by fearing the Lord and walking in God's ways. This week, let this mindset dominate all your relationships.

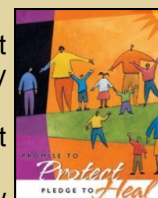

### BEST PREP FOR THE MOST NUTRITION

**Cooked Veggies:** Best method: Microwaved. "Properly cooking vegetables in the microwave can go a long way toward reducing nutrient loss," says registered dietitian Sandra Bastin, PhD. Microwaving limits the need for heat and water, both of which can cause vegetables to lose nutrients. Spanish researchers looked at the impact of cooking techniques on 20 different veggies, they discovered that microwaving ranked higher than boiling when it came to preserving antioxidants. Place veggies in a glass container with one to two tablespoons of water, and microwave on high until they are crisp and bright in color.
