The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, the RCIA, is a process which welcomes all who are interested in becoming Jesus' disciples in union with the Catholic Community, or any Catholic wishing to deepen their understanding of the faith. The Rite involves the formation of a community that learns, shares, builds community and prays together to deepen their relationship to God and to the parish family. The entire process leads to full commitment to God in and through the faith community, celebrated during the Easter Triduum of Holy Thursday, Good Friday and the Easter Vigil. This year, the key steps, rituals and dates are:

**August 29, 2019, 6 PM** - Initial getting to know one another gathering and meal


**September 5, 2019, 7-9 PM** - The first of our weekly Thursday evening gatherings



# Stewardship

"Martha, burdened with much serving, came to him and said, 'Lord, do you not care that my sister has left me by myself to do the serving? Tell her to help me.' The Lord said to her in reply, 'Martha, Martha, you are anxious and worried about many things. There is need of only one thing. Mary has chosen the better part and it will not be taken from her.'"

Luke 10:40-42

In today's Gospel reading from St. Luke, we receive a reminder about the proper use of the gift of time, a fundamental aspect of a stewardship way of life. Martha, as a good steward, welcomes Christ in, but then becomes "burdened with much serving" while her sister and fellow hostess chooses to simply sit with Jesus, listening to Him speak. Martha becomes indignant at Mary's behavior and complains to Jesus. But Jesus, in His infinite wisdom, refuses to get pulled into this sisterly spat. Instead, He offers Martha a fresh way to look at the situation. "Martha, Martha, you are anxious and worried about many things. There is need of only one thing." What is that one thing? It is to put Jesus first in our lives and above all other things; to "sit at his feet" and listen as Mary did, giving Him the first priority of our time no matter how busy we think we are. When we truly commit to putting Christ first in our daily lives through a regular time of prayer and frequent participation in the sacraments, we will find that all our other concerns become less pressing, less overwhelming. — See more at [www.catholicsteward.com/blog/](http://www.catholicsteward.com/blog/).



## Reflection on the Readings

The refrain from responsorial Psalm 15, "He who does justice will live in the presence of the Lord," focuses the message of both the first reading and the gospel. To do justice is to work on establishing right relationships with all people, attentive to their dignity as persons, respectful of their gifts, and responsive to their needs and concerns. One who does this "will live in the presence of the Lord." Attentiveness to self and neighbor is attentiveness to God, is living in the presence of God. **If we want to know how we are in our relationship to God, look at how we are in our relationships to our fellow human beings.**

**When relating to one another, hospitality is extremely important, especially in the case of the stranger, the wanderer, and the alien in our midst.** We reach out to the other simply because they are one with us in God's family, and they need our attention. There should be no other reason and no hidden agenda. **The Greek word for hospitality, *philoxenia*, literally means "love of the stranger."** This concept is foreign to modern day culture in which fear of the stranger is usually the dominant attitude. Look at the immigration issues of today both worldwide and at our borders, along with our attitude towards Muslims and others who appear different than we are.

**To do justice is to continually work on establishing right relationships.** We do this by first paying attention to what God wants those relationships to be. **The criteria for right relationships are established by God and not by us.** Unless we listen to God, like Abraham, Sarah, and Mary, we might miss what true hospitality is about. **Ultimately, true hospitality is the ability to be**

**attentive to the other as guest, listening to their concerns, attentive and responsive to their needs.** This encounter will ultimately lead to the establishment of right relationship. **If we take our eye off the other, our hospitality is not complete, no matter how much attention we have paid to the details of hospitality.**

Martha is so anxious and worried about details and preparations that she seems to minimize the encounter. Mary, while attuned to the encounter with the Lord, seems to minimize the practical aspects of hospitality. **This is not an either/or aspect of hospitality but a both/and aspect.** **To be good disciples, ministering and attending to others, we have to listen and be attentive to how God is present to us as well as do what is required of any disciple.** After all, last Sunday the Lord instructs us in the Parable of the Good Samaritan to "go and do likewise." Both doing and listening are integral to discipleship.

**Abraham and Sarah are busy with all the details of hospitality, but they stay focused on the encounter as well, and they are enriched by it with the promise of a long desired child.** The letter to the Colossians encourages us to attune ourselves to Christ in his life and sufferings, so that we can become effective ministers and

stewards to and for one another. **From such attunement comes the wisdom and insight to proclaim Christ to others, so that all may benefit from the rich encounter with the living Lord actively present among us.**

**Our Eucharistic celebrations are our hospitality encounter with the Lord.** We attune ourselves to listen to the Lord present in the scriptures, in the various ministers, in the bread and wine, and most especially in each of the people gathered. **We do this in the context of the ritual flow of our liturgies, attentive to them as a means of helping us encounter the living presence of the Lord among us.** However, if we become overly preoccupied with the details, rules or the exactness of the ritual, we may possibly miss the rich encounter with the Lord and one another. Again, both/and not either/or are essential aspects of hospitality.

**To do justice well, to encounter the other, one needs to act as well as reflect, to listen as well as follow through.** Doing one without attending to the other distorts hospitality and justice. **Reflect on how you pay attention to the dual aspects of hospitality. What can you do to make your hospitality a rich encounter with the other, as well as with God?**

## Reflexión Sobre las Lecturas

El Salmo responsorial 15 nos dice que el “que práctica la justicia” se hospedará en la tienda del Señor, y enfoca el mensaje tanto de la primera lectura como del evangelio. Practicar justicia es trabajar para establecer relaciones correctas con todos; atentos a su dignidad como personas, respetuosos de sus dones y receptivos a sus necesidades y preocupaciones. El que hace esto vivirá en la presencia del Señor. La atención al uno mismo y al prójimo es la atención a Dios, es vivir en la presencia de Dios. **Si queremos saber cómo estamos en nuestra relación con Dios, debemos ver cómo estamos en nuestras relaciones con los demás.**

Cuando nos relacionamos con los demás, la hospitalidad es extremadamente importante, especialmente en el caso del desconocido, el vagabundo y el extranjero entre nosotros. Nos acercamos al otro simplemente porque son uno con nosotros en la familia de Dios y necesitan nuestra atención. No debe haber ninguna otra razón ni una agenda oculta. **La palabra griega para la hospitalidad “philoxenia” significa literalmente “amor al desconocido”.** Este concepto es extraño a la cultura moderna en la que el miedo al desconocido suele ser la actitud dominante. Tome como ejemplo las cuestiones de inmigración de hoy, tanto a nivel mundial como en nuestras fronteras, junto con nuestra actitud hacia los musulmanes y otras personas que no se parecen a nosotros.

**Practicar justicia es trabajar continuamente para establecer relaciones correctas.** Hacemos esto prestando atención primero a como Dios quiere que sean esas relaciones. **Los criterios para las relaciones correctas son establecidos por Dios y no por nosotros.** A menos que escuchemos a Dios, como Abraham, Sara y María, podríamos perdernos de lo que se trata la verdadera hospitalidad. **En última instancia, la verdadera hospitalidad es la capacidad de estar atentos al otro como invitado, escuchando sus inquietudes, atentos a sus necesidades.** Este encuentro conducirá en última instancia al establecimiento de la relación correcta. **Si le quitamos la vista del otro, nuestra hospitalidad no está completa, sin importar cuánta atención hayamos prestado a los detalles de la hospitalidad.**

Marta está tan preocupada por los detalles y los preparativos que parece minimizar el encuentro. María, mientras está en sintonía con el encuentro con el Señor, parece minimizar los aspectos prácticos de la hospitalidad. **Este no es un aspecto de la hospitalidad de una a dos, sino uno de ambos. Para ser buenos discípulos, ministrar y atender a los demás, debemos escuchar y estar atentos a cómo Dios está presente para nosotros, así como hacer lo que se**

**requiere de cualquier discípulo.** Después de todo, el domingo pasado, el Señor nos instruye en la parábola del buen samaritano para que “vayamos y hagamos lo mismo”. Tanto hacer como escuchar son parte integral del discipulado.

**Abraham y Sara están ocupados con todos los detalles de la hospitalidad, pero también se enfocan en el encuentro, y se enriquecen con la promesa de un niño deseado durante mucho tiempo.** La carta a los Colosenses nos anima a sintonizarnos con Cristo en su vida y sufrimientos, para que podamos ser ministros y administradores eficaces por los demás. **De tal sintonía viene la sabiduría y la perspicacia para proclamar a Cristo a los demás, para que todos puedan beneficiarse del rico encuentro con el Señor vivo, presente activamente entre nosotros.**

**Nuestras celebraciones eucarísticas son nuestro encuentro hospitalario con el Señor.** Nos sintonizamos para escuchar al Señor presente en las Escrituras, en los diversos ministros, en el pan y el vino, y especialmente en cada una de las personas reunidas. **Hacemos esto en el contexto del flujo ritual de nuestras liturgias, atentos a ellos como un medio para ayudarnos a encontrar la presencia viva del Señor entre nosotros.** Sin embargo, si nos preocupamos demasiado por los detalles, las reglas o la exactitud del ritual, es posible que nos perdamos el rico encuentro con el Señor y con los demás. Nuevamente, ambos son aspectos esenciales de la hospitalidad, no una de las dos.

**Para practicar bien la justicia, encontrarse con el otro, uno necesita actuar y reflexionar, escuchar y cumplir.** Hacer uno sin atender al otro distorsiona la hospitalidad y la justicia. **Reflexione sobre cómo presta atención a los aspectos duales de la hospitalidad. ¿Qué puede hacer para hacer de su hospitalidad un encuentro rico con los demás, así como con Dios?**
