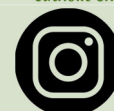

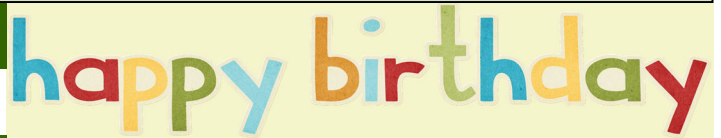

This Week's Do You Know Video:

Since 1894, Labor Day has been celebrated to acknowledge the contributions and achievements of American workers. In the late 1800s US workers were laboring fourteen hour days, seven days a week in horrendous working conditions with minimal pay just to eke out a basic living. Unions organized to defend workers' rights, leading to strikes and rallies which were vehemently and often violently opposed by employers, such as the Haymarket and the Pullman Railroad strikes. The Catholic Church, led by Pope Leo XIII at the time, was attuned to the violation of workers' rights and in 1891 Leo issued the first major Catholic Social Teaching encyclical, *Rerum Novarum*, defending workers' rights, the dignity of work, a just living wage, and active support of labor unions. 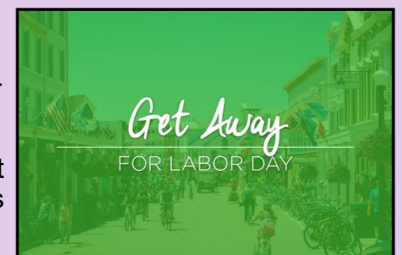

Did You Know— Labor Day weekend marks the last hurrah for summer travel. Take advantage of the long weekend and use these tips to *travel well*.

Travel well means thinking ahead and planning your trip to stay hydrated, protect against germs, select snacks for the road and an emergency kit. Pack these tips along with your clothes and enjoy your getaway.

1. **Stay hydrated-** Breathing dry air in an airplane can cause dehydration so be sure to drink 8 ounces of water before your flight. More importantly, continue to drink water while you are in flight. You'll land feeling ready to rock and roll!
2. **Protect against germs—** Whether you're traveling by air or you're in a car, germs are everywhere. Hand washing with soap and water is the best defense against germs. When soap and water isn't available, use an antibacterial gel.
3. **Pack healthy snacks—** Fill your snack bag with dried fruit, chopped veggies and fruits, nutrition bars with five or fewer natural ingredients along with nuts and seeds. These items will suppress your appetite while not adding too many calories.
4. **Keep up on your sleep—** Set an intentional bedtime while you're away. Shut down electronic devices one hour before bed. Make sure you're comfortable and drift off to slumber land.

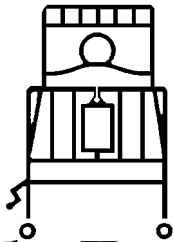

The scripture readings this Sunday challenge us once again to examine our commitment to discipleship, as well as to assess the cost involved in being a true disciple of Jesus. The readings challenge us to assess reality not in terms of our own perceptions but rather in terms of God's wisdom.

The first reading from the book of Wisdom concludes that only with God's help in teaching us wisdom from on high, are our paths on earth "made straight." If we were to rely solely on ourselves for wisdom, we would strive endlessly and end up with a confused and muddled version of wisdom. We would lose our way. **True wisdom has its source only in God, and not in our own devices.** The responsorial psalm emphasizes this focus by asking us to affirm our belief that "In every age, O Lord, you have been our refuge." **On our own, we cannot see clearly or discern properly. But God has been and continues to be our constant refuge in our search for wisdom.**

The passage from Paul's letter to Philemon is an excellent example of the challenge that God's wisdom offers us as we seek life's straight paths. Onesimus is an escaped slave of Philemon who befriended Paul and, through Paul, became a disciple of Jesus. Paul is writing to Philemon, also a follower of Jesus, asking him to consider how he is going to treat his returning slave. **In light of the bonding that they both have in Jesus, what does God's wisdom, which is the only means to life's "straight paths," now require of Philemon?**

Paul counsels Philemon to treat Onesimus as a brother in the Lord and no longer as a slave. This approach would certainly challenge Philemon's cultural and innate understanding of the relationship between master and slave. **God's path and wisdom place significant demands on our human ways of thinking, asking us to judge by God's criteria and not ours.**

Luke's gospel passage challenges us in the same way. Our possessions, our relationships, our very human need for planning and thinking ahead can be real sources of distraction in our attempt to take on God's perspective and wisdom. **Luke's Jesus continually challenges us to focus consistently on**

what matters most, namely following and imitating him, God's true wisdom. All else falls by the wayside in comparison to this overarching focus.

This is precisely the perspective that underlies Jesus' proclamation to his followers of "hating...father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters and even his own life...." **Jesus is not literally saying that we are to hate and despise all those that we love and cherish. Rather, he is using a style of speaking that emphasizes the priorities demanded of any disciple. God's way of thinking and acting is to come first above all else, even the most cherished of relationships.**

The demands of discipleship are centered on God, and clearly articulated for us in the words and actions of God's incarnate wisdom, Jesus. If we desire to be Christ's disciples, such commitment demands a significant cost, symbolized by the cross that we continually sign ourselves with, and that each of us is challenged to carry in living out our baptismal commitment. **The demand can be overwhelming unless we continually recall and proclaim the refrain of the psalm, "In every age, O Lord, you have been our refuge."**

This week, think of people and/or times when you have been challenged to see things not from your own limited perspective but from God's perspective. Thank God for bringing such people or situations into your life. **For it is in the struggle to discern life's "straight paths" that we come closer to knowing God's true wisdom.**

Las lecturas de las Escrituras de este domingo nos retan una vez más a examinar nuestro compromiso con el discipulado, así como a evaluar el costo que implica ser un verdadero discípulo de Jesús. Las lecturas nos desafían a evaluar la realidad no en términos de nuestras propias percepciones, sino en términos de la sabiduría de Dios.

La primera lectura de Sabiduría concluye que solo con la ayuda de Dios al enseñarnos la sabiduría de lo alto, nuestros caminos en la tierra están "enderezados". Si confiáramos únicamente en nosotros para obtener sabiduría, nos esforzaríamos sin cesar y terminaríamos con una versión confusa y poca clara de la sabiduría. Perderíamos nuestro camino. **La verdadera sabiduría tiene su fuente solo en Dios, y no en nuestros propios dispositivos.** El salmo responsorial enfatiza este enfoque al pedirnos que afirmemos nuestra creencia de que "Señor, tú has sido nuestro refugio de generación en generación". **Por nuestra cuenta, no podemos ver con claridad ni discernir adecuadamente. Pero Dios ha sido y continúa siendo nuestro refugio constante en nuestra búsqueda de sabiduría.**



El pasaje de la carta de Pablo a Filemón es un excelente ejemplo del desafío que la sabiduría de Dios nos ofrece al buscar los caminos derechos de la vida. Onésimo es un esclavo escapado de Filemón quien se hizo amigo de Pablo y, a través de Pablo, se convirtió en discípulo de Jesús. Pablo le escribe a Filemón, también seguidor de Jesús, pidiéndole que considere cómo va a tratar a su esclavo que regresa. **A la luz del vínculo que ambos tienen en Jesús, ¿qué requiere la sabiduría de Dios, que es el único medio para los "caminos derechos" de la vida, ahora de Filemón?**

Pablo aconseja a Filemón que trate a Onésimo como un hermano en el Señor y ya no como un esclavo. Este enfoque ciertamente desafiaría la comprensión cultural e innata de Filemón de la relación entre amo y esclavo. **El camino y la sabiduría de Dios imponen demandas significativas sobre nuestras formas humanas de pensar, y nos piden que juzguemos según los criterios de Dios y no los nuestros.**

El pasaje del evangelio de Lucas nos desafía de la misma manera. Nuestras posesiones, nuestras relaciones, nuestra necesidad muy humana de planificar y pensar con anticipación pueden ser fuentes reales de distracción en nuestro intento de asumir la perspectiva y la sabiduría de Dios. **El Jesús de Lucas continuamente nos reta a enfocarnos constantemente en lo que más importa, a saber, seguirlo e imitarlo, la verdadera sabiduría de Dios. Todo lo demás queda atrás en comparación con este enfoque general.**

Esta es precisamente la perspectiva que subyace en la proclamación de Jesús a sus seguidores de si "no me prefiere a su padre y a su madre, a su esposa y a sus hijos, a sus hermanos y a sus hermanas, mas aun, a si mismo..." **Jesús no está literalmente diciendo que debemos despreciar a todos los que amamos y apreciamos. Más bien, está usando un estilo de hablar que enfatiza las prioridades exigidas a cualquier discípulo. La forma de pensar y actuar de Dios es primero que nada, incluso las relaciones más preciadas.**

Las demandas del discipulado se centran en Dios, y están claramente articuladas para nosotros en las palabras y acciones de la sabiduría encarnada de Dios, Jesús. Si deseamos ser discípulos de Cristo, dicho compromiso exige un costo significativo, simbolizado por la cruz con la que nos persignamos continuamente, y que cada uno de nosotros tiene el desafío de llevar a cabo nuestro compromiso bautismal. **La demanda puede ser abrumadora a menos que recordemos y proclamemos continuamente el estribillo del salmo: "Señor, tú has sido nuestro refugio de generación en generación".**

Esta semana, piense en las personas y/o en los momentos en que ha sido desafiado a ver las cosas no desde su propia perspectiva limitada sino desde la perspectiva de Dios. 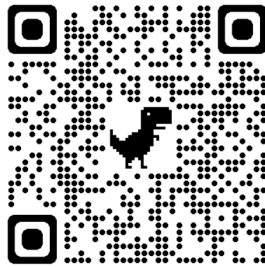

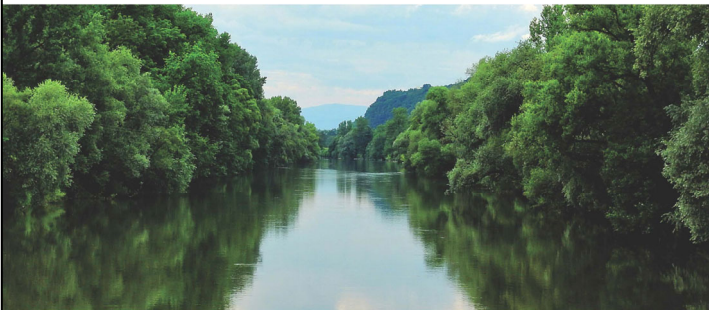

"It is necessary to state firmly once more that nothing and no one can in any way permit the killing of an innocent human being, whether a fetus or an embryo, an infant or an adult, an old person, or one suffering from an incurable disease, or a person who is dying. Furthermore, no one is permitted to ask for this act of killing, either for himself or herself or for another person entrusted to his or her care, nor can he or she consent to it, either explicitly or implicitly. Nor can any authority legitimately recommend or permit such an action. For it is a question of the violation of the divine law, an offense against the dignity of the human person, a crime against life, and an attack on humanity."

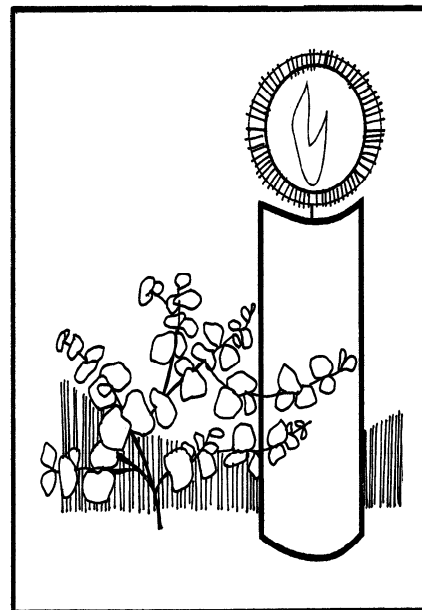
