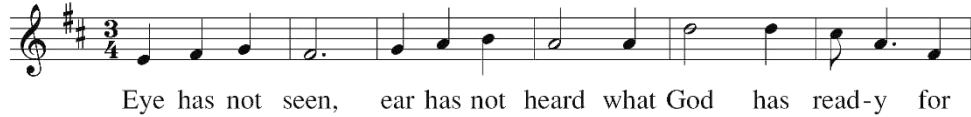
Communion

Prayer for Spiritual Communion

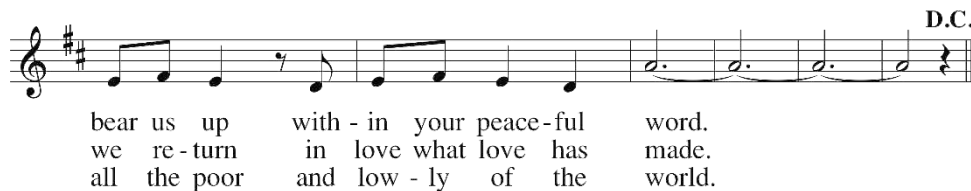

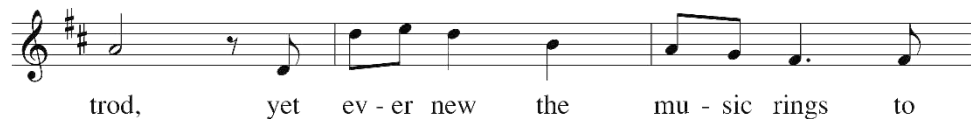
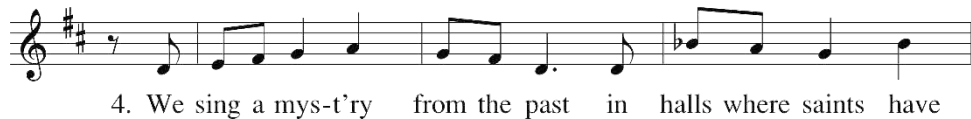
