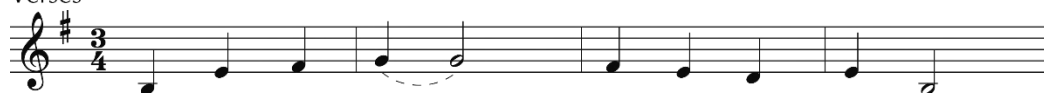
Communion
